How Many Letters in Basmalah??

The first verse of the Quran "In the name of God, Most Gracious, Most Merciful," known as the "Basmalah," occupies a special position in the Quran. It is the opening statement for all chapters except one and constitutes the basis of the Quran's 19-based mathematical composition.

The *Basmalah* consists of 19 Arabic letters within 4 words. Each of these words [Bism Allah Al-Rahman Al-Raheem] occur in the Quran in multiples of 19: 19, 2698, 57 and 114 times respectively.

People with disease in their hearts adamantly oppose the Quranic fact that the *Basmalah* has 19 letters. Ignorance and ego keep them astray. They demonstrate this fact by saying "The *Basmalah* has either 17 or 22 letters, we are not sure; but they aren't 19 for sure". These people also do not accept the Quran's mathematical composition, of which God Himself says "this is one of the greatest miracles" (74:36).

The Quran's mathematical composition is so vast and intricate that we do not expect these people who cannot even count simple letters to go beyond the opening verse in the Quran. However, it is no longer a matter of guesswork how many letters are in the *Basmalah*. The following discoveries, made in accordance with God's will, prove their number:

The *Basmalah* consists of 4 words. Each word has 3,4,6 and 6 (Arabic) letters as shown below with the gematrical value of each letter:

Word in <i>Basmalah</i>	No. of Letters	Gematrical Values
1. Bism	3	2, 60, 40
2. Allah	4	1, 30, 30, 5
3. Al-Rahman	6	1, 30, 200, 8, 40, 50
4. Al-Raheem	6	1, 30, 200, 8, 10, 40

1) Let us write the position (or the number) of the word followed by the number of letters in each word:

$$1\ 3\ 2\ 4\ 3\ 6\ 4\ 6 = 19 \times 19 \times 36686$$

If we reverse the word order, the result is still divisible by 19:

$$4\ 6\ 3\ 6\ 2\ 4\ 1\ 3 = 19 \times 2440127$$

2) Instead of the number of letters in each word, let us use the total gematrical value of the letters in these words:

$$1\ 102\ 2\ 66\ 3\ 329\ 4\ 289 = 19 \times 5801401752331$$

3) Now, if all the above is sheer coincidence, what can we say to the following: Replace the total gematrical value of the letters in each word by the individual gematrical value of each letter:

$$1\ 2\ 60\ 40\ 2\ 1\ 30\ 30\ 5\ 3\ 1\ 30\ 200\ 8\ 40\ 50\ 4\ 1\ 30\ 200\ 8\ 10\ 40 = 19 \times 66336954226595422109686863843162160$$

The sum of digits of the above 37-digit number is 76, 19×4 . Furthermore, when we reverse the word order (similar to what will happen when the *Basmalah* is written in Arabic), we still get a number divisible by 19 as follows:

$$4\ 1\ 30\ 200\ 8\ 10\ 40\ 3\ 1\ 30\ 200\ 8\ 40\ 50\ 2\ 1\ 30\ 30\ 5\ 1\ 2\ 60\ 40 = 19 \times 217378990021217378991605375279217160$$

4) The following discovery further proves the letters and their orders in the *Basmalah*, in which gematrical value of each letter is followed by the numerical order of the letter:

$$2\ 1\ 60\ 2\ 40\ 3\ 1\ 4\ 30\ 5\ 30\ 6\ 5\ 7\ 1\ 8\ 30\ 9\ 200\ 10\ 8\ 11\ 40\ 12\ 50\ 13\ 1\ 14\ 30\ 15\ 200\ 16\ 8\ 17\ 10\ 18\ 40\ 19$$

The above number when put side by side is 62 digits long and divisible by 19. We thank God for blessing us with these discoveries. We thank also brother Sharif for sending the discovery #1 which led us to discover the rest. God bless him and us all.

The Messenger of the Covenant is in Heaven with his Lord

On January 31, 1990, sometime before dawn, Dr. Rashad Khalifa, God's Messenger of the Covenant, was martyred by one or more disbelievers who broke into the mosque earlier at night and waited for him to come in for the morning prayer and for the study of the scripture.

Why did God allow such an action?

The slayings of God's prophets and the messengers are not new. We learn from Quran (2:87, 3:21, 3:183) that several prophets and messengers were killed in the cause of God by disbelievers who disliked and rejected the message they preached, which has always been, "There is no God except He. Worship Him alone." God does not terminate the life of His messengers until they deliver their message and serve their function in this world. Dr. Rashad Khalifa served as a messenger for 19 years. During this time, he taught and spread the message to worship God alone and to follow the Quran alone. He translated the Quran into English. He unveiled the Quran's mathematical 19-based composition. He removed the two false verses from the Quran, thus restoring the pure Quran for us and for future generations, by God's leave. Finally, he established a strong group of believers who are knowledgeable about the Quran and ready to continue to deliver the message to the world in accordance with God's will.

This is God's plan

We know that everybody has a pre-determined life span and that they can never change it by one minute. "No one dies except by God's leave, at a predetermined time..." (3:145). If the messenger of God was in his bed sleeping instead of coming to the mosque that morning, he would have died in his bed anyway (3:154). However, it was God's will and plan to coincide the disbelievers' action with the time that He would terminate the life of His messenger, in order to give him an honorable exit. God reassures us with the example of Jesus that Dr. Rashad Khalifa's soul was raised before the disbelievers struck: "...For certain, they never killed him. Instead, God raised him to Him; God is Almighty, Most Wise" (4:157-158, 3:55).

The messenger is in Heaven

However the case might be about be termination of his life, the messenger of God is now in Heaven with his Lord, enjoying it: "Do not think that those who are killed in the cause of God are dead; they are alive at their Lord, being provided for"(3:169, 2:154).

Expect retribution from God

God sent His messengers to serve as preachers and warners. The communities that reject the messengers and the message he brings are destined to be doomed (17:15-17, 3:56, 23:44, 30:47). God allows the disbelievers to carry on for awhile. Then, the retribution comes to them when they least expect it. This has been the system of God; God's system is never changeable. The victory inevitably belongs to the believers and this is a promise from God. (6:48-49, 8:33, 13:32, 22:44). "We have sent messengers before you to their people, with profound signs. Subsequently, we punished those who transgressed. For it is our duty to give victory to the believers" (30:47).

GOD WILLING

The time has come for us to stand strong with God, We must be united working for our common goal. No adversity will deter us, we'll be steadfast and true, "Worship God alone" is our message to spread to the world.

The messenger was taken, his mission complete, His time of earthly departure decreed by God long ago. Though they think that they killed him and rejoice in this lie, His empty garment was all they found
—for God took his soul to Paradise.

The responsibility is now ours, there is no turning back, We'll move forward, and onward, for God's work must be done. Though they believe they have stopped future spread of God's word God's truth shall prevail for God's message will never die.

Note: Sequential Value of Arabic Letters is obtained by writing the 28 letters of the Arabic alphabet, then assigning sequential numbers to them, from 1 to 28. The discovery in the first column was made earlier by sister Suad. The discovery in the last column was made by brother Farid, Riverside, California.

REASSURANCE FROM GOD

"Not a leaf falls without His knowledge..." (6:59). It was a pre-determined decision by God to terminate the life of His messenger from this world in accordance with His plan. God blessed us with several signs after this incident to assure and strengthen our hearts regarding several issues:

1. God controls everything, including our birth and termination of our lives. For example, the messenger of the covenant was born on November 19, 1935 and was martyred on January 31, 1990. Let us take these two dates and add the digits of the numbers for the days, months and years:

$$1 + 3 + 1 + 1 + 9 + 9 + 0 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 9 + 1 + 9 + 3 + 5 = 54$$

Dr. Rashad Khalifa was 54 years old when he was martyred.

Now, take the above numbers and put them side by side to make a single (15-digit) number. This number is divisible by 19 as follows:

$$1\ 31\ 1990\ 11\ 19\ 1935 = 19 \times 6905211115365$$

Now, let us write the above number backwards. The resulting number is also divisible by 19, not only once, but three times:

$$5391\ 91\ 11\ 0991\ 13\ 1 = 19 \times 19 \times 19 \times 78610746609$$

Note that the digits of the last number also adds up to 54.

2. The messenger of God is in heaven right now. There are two verses in the Quran (2:154 and 3:169) which state that those who are killed in the cause of God are not dead, they are alive and well at their Lord, being provided for. These two verses are also correlated by the fact that $154 + 169 = 323 = 19 \times 17$.

Let us write the date the messenger was martyred followed by the verse 2:154 as follows: $1\ 31\ 1990\ 2\ 154 = 19 \times 690521166$.

Although the other verse (3:169) does not give a divisible number when the same method is applied, it combines with the above date in another way. For example, if we take the number 3169 and add to the date 1-31-90, we get the following:

$$3169 + 13190 = 16359 = 19 \times 861$$

The number 16359 is unique in that when it is written backwards, it is also divisible by 19: $95361 = 19 \times 5019$.

Furthermore, the numbers 95 and 361, which make up the number 95361, are both divisible by 19:

$$95 = 5 \times 19 \quad \text{and} \quad 361 = 19 \times 19$$

Incidentally, verse 5:19 in Quran is a reminder for the people: "O people of the scripture, our messenger has come to you, to recite to you, after a period of time without messengers, lest you say, 'We did not receive any preacher or warner.' A preacher has now come to you. God is omnipotent."

The messenger referred to in this verse is Dr. Rashad Khalifa whose total gematrial value of his first name (505) and his last name (725) add up to 1254 with 5 and 19:

$$505 + 725 + 5 + 19 = 1254 = 19 \times 66$$

3. "...For certain, they never killed him" (4:157)
"Instead, God raised him to Him..." (4:158)

These verses are God's example to us in the Quran, through the history of Jesus Christ, that God raises His messengers to Him before the disbelievers strike, in accordance with His plan.

Let us take the above verses 4:157-158, the date 1-31-1990, and the gematrial values of Rashad Khalifa, 505 725. These numbers add up to the following:

$$4157158 + 1311990 + 505725 = 5974873 = 19 \times 314467$$

Instead of 4:157-158, if we take only 4:157, then we get:

$$4157 + 1311990 + 505725 = 1821872 = 19 \times 95888$$

Let us add these numbers in a different way:

$$4 + 157 + 1 + 31 + 1990 + 505725 = 507908 = 19 \times 26732$$

Also, there is a simple relationship with verse 157 as follows:

$$157 + 505 + 725 = 1387 = 19 \times 73$$

The verse 4:158 makes the following combinations:

$$4158 + 1 + 31 + 1990 + 505 + 725 = 7410 = 19 \times 390$$

If we express the date 1-31-90 by 13190, we get the following with verses 4:157 and 4:157-158:

$$4157 + 13190 = 17347 = 19 \times 913$$

$$4157158 + 13190 = 4170348 = 19 \times 219492$$

4) The retribution is inevitable and might be coming soon: There are several verses in the Quran that mention the retribution of communities after rejecting the messenger. For example, verse 30:47 says "We have sent messengers before you to their people, with profound signs. Subsequently, we punished those who transgressed. For it is our duty to give victory to the believers." The verses 3:56 and 23:44 are equally strong. Now if we take these verses and combine them with the date 1-31-1990, we get the following:

$$1\ 31\ 1990\ 3\ 56 = 19 \times 69052124$$

$$1\ 31\ 1990\ 23\ 44 = 19 \times 690521176$$

$$1\ 31\ 1990\ 30\ 47 = 19 \times 690521213$$

These verses also combine with the gematrial values of Rashad Khalifa as follows:

$$505\ 725\ 3\ 56 = 19 \times 26617124$$

$$505\ 725\ 23\ 44 = 19 \times 266171176$$

$$505\ 725\ 30\ 47 = 19 \times 266171213$$

These are signs that the retribution will come after the messenger leaves us. This prophesy of retribution is clear in verse 44:13 which says "Now they remember! A manifest messenger HAD COME to them." This verse makes the following compositions, all divisible by 19:

$$44 + 13 = 57 = 19 \times 3$$

$$44\ 13\ 505\ 725 = 19 \times 232289775$$

$$44\ 13 + 505 + 725 = 5643 = 19 \times 297$$
